Day 4 Our excursion today takes us to the beautiful water village of Geithoorn. Here we have included a boat cruise to see the best of this pretty little village known as the Venice of the Netherlands.

Day 5 Leaving Arnhem today we travel to Keukenhof which is known as 'The Greatest Flower Show on Earth'. Every year, almost a million people flock from all over the world to see the world's largest bulb garden come to life with displays of tulips, hyacinths and daffodils. You can also admire the colourful arrays of ornamental shrubs, blossoming fruit trees and natural woodland. We then make our way to Rotterdam for our return ferry crossing with dinner, bed, breakfast & entertainment provided.

Day 6 After breakfast on board we depart the ferry and rejoin our coach for the journey back home with a suitable comfort stop provided.

Our base for this holiday is the family run 4 Star Kirchbergerhof, in the heart of the Kitzbuheler Alps. The hotel has a spa area which includes a swimming pool, steam bath and sauna.

Itinerary*

Day 1 Departing our local area we travel to Hull and allow free time in this recent city of culture before boarding the P&O overnight ferry to Rotterdam with dinner, bed & breakfast provided. Sit back, relax and enjoy the excellent entertainment on board as we set sail for the continent.

Day 2 After breakfast on board the ferry we travel through the Netherland's into Germany and on to our hotel in Karlsruhe, the 4 star Achat Hotel with dinner, bed and breakfast provided.

Day 3 After breakfast this morning we travel through Bavaria and into Austria where we make a stop at the border town of Kufstein with its medieval fortress that contains the Heroes Organ 'Heldenorgel' boasting 4307 pipes. Leaving Kufstein we make our way to Kirchberg and the 4 star Kirchbergerhof Hotel, our base for the next 5 nights with dinner, bed and breakfast.

Day 4 After a leisurely breakfast today, our excursion explores the local area taking in the charms of fashionable Kitzbuhel, one of the oldest and exclusive holiday resorts in the Austrian Alps.

Day 5 Our journey today takes us though the picturesque Lofer valley to the home of 'The Sound of Music' and regional capital of Salzburgerland, Salzburg. We have included a guided city coach tour in order to see the sights from the hit movie which we're sure will leave you feeling like a Von Trapp Family singer. After we can explore the city at our leisure, the old town is a maze of charming pedestrian alleyways with many famous and historic landmarks such as Mozart's Birthplace, Schloss Mirabell and the Mirabell Gardens.

Day 6 Today we take a scenic drive via Mittersill into the beautiful Hohe Tauern National Park. We stop for lunch at leisure in the delightful village of Heiligenblut which nestles at the foot of the mighty Grossglockner, Austria's highest mountain. From here we travel on the Grossglockner High Alpine Road, one of the highest Alpine passes in Europe. During our journey we stop at the Franz- Josef-Höhe viewpoint to admire the outstanding scenery before continuing on our circular route back to our hotel.

Day 7 This morning, we travel through Fieberbrunn in the Pillersee valley to the pretty town of Zell am See, nestled on the shores of lovely Lake Zell. Here you may wish to enjoy a panoramic boat cruise (extra cost) before spending time wandering through the medieval centre and along the lake shore.

Day 8 After breakfast today we bid farewell to Austria and travel back into Germany passing through Bavaria and into Baden-Wurtemmburg to our hotel in Karlsruhe, the 4 star Leonardo hotel with dinner, bed and breakfast.







Day 9 Today we travel through Germany and into the Netherlands with suitable comfort stops en-route as we make our way to Rotterdam. Our return ferry crossing includes dinner, bed, breakfast & entertainment whilst on board the ship.

Day 10 After breakfast on board we depart the ferry and rejoin our coach for the journey back home with a suitable comfort stop provided.

Day 1 Departing your local departure point we travel to Huntingdon and the 4 Star Marriot, our base for the next 4 nights.

Day 2 Our destination this morning is the Imperial War Museum Duxford, Britain's best preserved World War II airfield. Its story reflects the landmark achievements made in aviation history and it incorporates a series of museums and exhibitions such as the 1940s Operations Room, Airspace (featuring 30 iconic aircraft including the Spitfire and Concorde), The American Air Museum (with the largest collection of US historic military aircraft in Europe), The Battle of Britain Exhibition, RAF Duxford's pivotal role and Land Warfare to name but a few. We spend the afternoon at leisure in Cambridge, with a choice of famous attractions to explore.

Day 3 Today, we enjoy a fascinating private guided tour of Rockingham Castle, a castle with the rare status of having been continuously occupied for nearly 1,000 years and by just one family since being relinquished as a royal castle. On arrival we enjoy tea and coffee, followed by our tour, with time afterwards to explore the gardens, grounds, church and ice house at leisure.

Day 4 This morning, we make our way to Bletchley Park where Alan Turing and his colleagues helped crack Germany's Enigma Code during World War II. We uncover Bletchley Park's remarkable story by visiting the unglamorous, functional Code Breaking Huts and Blocks, Alan Turing's office, the Library, the wartime garages complete with World War II vehicles and a series of fascinating interactive exhibits before enjoying lunch (not included) in Hut 4 (formerly home to World War II Naval Intelligence Code Breaking Operations).

Day 5 After breakfast today we return home with suitable comfort stops En-route.

Day 1 Departing your local pick up point today we make our way to Holyhead for the ferry across to Ireland. Leaving the ferry we travel to our overnight hotel, the Midlands Park in Portlaoise. Here we spend the night with dinner, bed and breakfast provided.

Day 2 After breakfast today we head for Killarney calling enroute to visit to the charming town of Cashel in County Tipperary, which dates from medieval times. With undulating hills, soaring mountains, rugged coastline and picturesque, traditional villages, each twist and turn of the scenic tour will reveal amazing sights and spectacular views. Our journey returns through the famed Molls Gap, stunning Ladies' View and Killarney National Park.

Day 4 (Drivers day off) Today we have arranged a Jaunting Car Tour, the perfect way to see the hidden delights of the Killarney National Park and the famous Lakes of Killarney. The Tangney family, whose jaunting business has been in operation for over 220 years, will welcome you on board their pony and trap rides and take you on an exciting tour of the area using roads not open to regular traffic followed by free time in Killarney.

Day 5 After breakfast today we enjoy a scenic tour of the Dingle Peninsula. The Dingle Peninsula or Corca Dhuibhne stretches 30 miles into the Atlantic Ocean from Ireland's southwest coast. The peninsula is dominated by the range of mountains that form its spine. We visit the picturesque fishing town of Dingle, before heading west to Slea Head, Europe's most westerly point, whose outlying historic Blasket Islands are known as 'the next parish to America'.

Day 6 We head to Dublin today where we have included a guided city coach tour. 11. INSURANCE:


